Thiana Reyes led off the frame with a hit by pitch, Martha Garcia singled to right and both runners advanced one base on a error, Daniela Rodriguez reached on an error to drive in both Thiana Reyes and Martha Garcia, Ariana Soto followed with a one hop RBI double into the left field gap to bring home Daniela Rodriguez, with one out Jasmin Ballones came through with an RBI single to tally Ariana Soto with two outs Kayla Sifuentes connected with and RBI single to bring home Jasmin Ballones, Anissa Salazar belted and RBI double to tally Kayla Sifuentes to give the Lady Mavericks a 6 to 3 lead over the Lady Cardinals.

That proved to be more than enough lead for relief hurler Angie Escamilla who took over the pitching chores from starting pitcher Amy Flores in the top of the fourth and was simply dominant inside the circle.
