The Pride of Southern Maverick County, the defending Bi-District finalist C.C. Winn Mavericks varsity football team under the direction of sixth year head football coach Eric Villasenor will hit the road on Friday, August 31, 2018 to the Spinach Capital of the World Crystal City, Texas to kickoff their 2018 Texas High School football season with a 7:30 PM non-district gridiron encounter. The Mavericks venture into this season with their sights focused on capturing the District 14-5A football championship and earning a berth into the post season for the third consecutive year.

The home standing Crystal City Javelinas out of District 14-4A Division II will be under the tutelage of head football coach David Lopez return the services of 5 offensive and 5 defensive starters from an Area finalist squad that culminated last season with a 9-3 overall season record.

Offensively the Crystal City Javelinas will be spearhead by their standout running back David Patino who is big, strong with great speed and tough to bring down who last season gained 1029 yards rushing and tallied 15 touchdowns on the ground, Starting signal caller for the Javelinas is expected to be John Saucedo with the offensive line featuring Alfonso Mata and Michael Cuevas and tight end Nathan Arredondo.

Defensively the Javelinas will have two way starter Michael Cuevas and John Lomas on the front line, with Justin Morales and Justin Bonilla at linebackers. Stellar running back David Patino is also a two way starter and will be the leader of the Javelinas defensive secondary.

The 2018 C.C. Winn Mavericks offense under the guidance of offensive coordinator Heriberto Roiz will be led by their talented starting quarterback Ethan Johnston #2 who lead the team in rushing with 156 carries for nearly 800 yards with 9 rushing touchdowns as well as in passing with 70 completions out of 124 attempts for 900 yards and threw 3 TD passes. Joining him in the backfield will be Marc Cardenas #22 and Fernando Zapata #24 who will share the running back duties for the Mavericks.

The perennial massive offensive line will feature Daniel Ruiz #50 as the starting center with Adrian Munoz #74 and Juan Guerra #72 at guards with Cesar Valdez #79 and Jaime Rodriguez #73 at tackles.

The Mavericks passing game will feature Jose Blanco #88 and Ernesto Vasquez #13 as the wide receivers with Jared Roiz #6 and Raul Solis #23 as the inside receivers.
