The Mavericks received the game's opening kickoff but after minimal gain they were forced to punt the ball on fourth which the Dragons managed to return the ball to the Mavericks 33 yard line. It took just one play from scrimmage for the Dragons a tally the first score of the game when quarterback Michael Luna connected with his fast multi-talented running back Mahki Johnson with a 33 yard touchdown pass with 9:38 showing nth first quarter clock. Oscar Jimenez tacked on the point after to give the Dragons the early 7 to 0 lead over the Mavericks.
