The 2018 C.C. Winn Mavericks mentored by head coach Eric Villasenor ventured to the Heart of the Winter Garden area of Carrizo Springs, Texas to kickoff their respective first controlled scrimmage of the 2018 season with a 7:00 PM gridiron encounter against the home standing Carrizo Springs Wildcats. The Mavericks offense and defensive looked pretty solid during this scrimmage racking up a total of 325 yards of offense with 150 yards passing and 175 yards rushing.

The Mavericks perennially hard hitting stingy defense only allowed a total of 150 yards to the Wildcats with 90 yards passing and only 60 yards rushing.

During the controlled portion of this scrimmage both teams scored one touchdown apiece with the Mavericks utilizing both their passing assault and running attack quite successfully against the Wildcats. The Mavericks tallied on a 10 yard run from their standout quarterback Ethan Johnston behind the excellent block of the Mavericks offensive line. The Mavericks young receiving corps made some key plays throughout this entire scrimmage to compliment the Mavericks patented running game.

In the live portion of this first scrimmage the Mavericks shutout the Wildcats with their famed aggressive and hard hitting defense featuring linebackers Patricio Hernandez and Jared Roiz who recorded a key interception in this matchup. Defensive linemen Ricky Morales and Alejandro Ontiveros had a bi night with key tackles and applying relentless pressure on the Wildcats offense. The Mavericks swarming defensive backs came up with some big plays in this scrimmage with German Velasquez and Domingo Duran covering the Wildcats receivers with suffocating blanket coverage and applied some big hits on the Wildcats running backs on run support. Mavericks' safety Javier Cerda inflicted a bone shattering hit on the Wildcats ball carrier causing and recovering a key fumble on that play.

During the live portion of this scrimmage the Mavericks offense simply dominated the line of scrimmage enabling them to matriculate down the field mixing up their passing and running game for big yardage. The Mavericks mounted the lone scoring drive during the live portion capping off the drive with a five yard keeper by quarterback Ethan Johnston to give the Mavericks the 14 to 7 victory over the Carrizo Springs Wildcats much to the delight of the fairly large Mavericks Nation in attendance that came to see their beloved mighty C.C. Winn
